

04 | Anami Coast



Swimming and camping can be enjoyed in a cove where rocky reefs called "Senjojiki" (meaning one thousand tatami mats) and a white sand beach are next to each other. In addition, a variety of landforms such as an island called "Kaeru Island (frog island)" which is named because its shape resembles a frog and Shiraishi Island which has a mysterious shape resembling a sole of a foot or a gem.

10 | Takenohama Beach



This is a shallow sandy beach of about 800 m in length with beautiful clear water. This is one of the Japan, which has been consecutively selected as one of "the 100 best swimming beaches of Japan" of 006, "the 88 best swimming beaches of Japan" of 2001, "the 55 best swimming beaches of Japan" of 1998, and "the 100 best beaches of Japan" of 1996.

11 | Shotenkyo



This is a beautiful sandy beach area separating Kumihama Bay and the Sea of Japan and has been selected as one of Kyoto's Top 200 Nature

It has been called "Shotenkyo" which means a "small bridge to heaven" since its landform resembles "Amanohashidate (the Bridge to Heaven)."

12 | Tango Sand Dunes



These sand dunes stretch approximately 7 km in length from the mouth of the Kumihama Bay to the river mouth of Kizugawa River and are a popular beach for swimming during the summer. In addition, valuable coastal plants such as Veronica ornata inhabit the


13 | Goshikihama Coast


